General Policies

- Behavior
 - Your behavior in this class must show respect for others and yourself.
 - When class time is given for homework, you will be expected to use it.
 - Warnings or detentions may result from failing to following these rules.

- A graphing calculator will be checked out to you if you don't already have one. You must return it at the end of the year or pay \$100 to replace it.

Grading

- Homework: worth **5** points for each day's assignment. These are awarded mostly on effort.
- 3-min Quiz: worth **10** points.
- Quizzes: worth **10** points.
- Notes: worth **10** points. More explanation will be given later.
- Tests: worth **100** points. Partial credit may be given if you show your work.
- Any other assignments will vary in point value and will be explained when assigned.
- Grades will be figured by **dividing points correct by points possible.**

Extra Credit

- Quizzes and Tests have extra credit
- We will have homework groups each chapter. Starting with the second test, the group that improves their test average the most from the previous chapter will get 5 points extra credit per person.
- **I do NOT give worksheets for extra credit.**

Makeup Work

- **It will be your responsibility to get makeup assignments and get them in on time. I will not remind you about them.** Assignments will be posted daily on the bulletin board.
- You have **two days** to turn in assignments for every day you missed.
- It is recommended that you get makeup assignment your first day back at school, even if our class doesn't meet that day.
- It is your responsibility to make arrangements with me to makeup tests.
- **You will take the test with the rest of the class unless you miss 2 review days.**

Late Work
